

New Providence Green League 7u Rules

All Cal Ripken and NPGL rules apply to the **7u** division with these exceptions:

- 1. INNINGS 1,2 and 5,6 will be COACH PITCH. Coaches will pitch to their own team.
 - Each batter will get 5 coach pitches to hit the ball. The batter will be out after 3 swinging strikes or at the end of 5 pitches, whichever occurs first.
 - If the batter has not put the ball into play after 5 pitches it is an out.
 - If the batter fouls off the 5th pitch they will be given one more pitch to put the ball in play.
 - **"PITCHERS HELPER"** A "pitcher's helper" will be played during coach pitch innings if roster size allows. The pitcher's helper is a player who is positioned to field balls hit "up the middle."
 - The Coach/pitcher should make all efforts not to interfere with the player or affect batted balls in any way.
 - The pitcher's helper must stand within a 6-foot radius of, but no closer to home plate than, the coach pitching. The umpire shall enforce all safe distances at his/her discretion.
 - The Coach/Pitcher must make an "honest effort" to catch balls thrown to him/her by any defensive player. If, in the Umpire's discretion, an honest effort is not given, the lead runner will be called out.
- 2. INNINGS 3 and 4 will be PLAYER PITCH (4 Balls and 3 Strikes).
 - NPGL pitch count rules apply.

3. PITCHING DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- PLAYER PITCH distance must be a minimum of 40 feet and a maximum of 46 feet.
- COACH PITCH distance must be a minimum of **30 feet** and a maximum of **46 feet**.
- 4. <u>NO</u> new inning may start after 1 hour and 45 minutes from time of first pitch.
- 5. A 5-RUN MAXIMUM per inning applies, with the exception of the last inning.

- The time limit of 1-hour 45 minutes always applies regardless of score. Tie games are allowed.

6. <u>NO</u> bunting

- 7. <u>NO</u> leading or stealing is permitted. Runners may only advance on a ball in play.
 - Each team will get one umpire's warning for a runner leaving early. All subsequent violations will be called as an out.
- 8. A batter hit by a COACH pitch is <u>not</u> awarded first base. It counts as a pitch.
- 9. A batter hit by a PLAYER pitch is awarded first base.
- 10. <u>NO</u> Infield Fly Rule
- 11. <u>NO</u> sliding into first base.
- 12. ALL runners must slide feet first. Head-first sliders will be called out.
- 13. Play is only stopped when the ball is returned to the pitcher (COACH or PLAYER) in the *general area* of the mound (Umpire discretion).
 - Runners in-between bases are awarded the next base on ball-back-to-pitcher throws if half-way or more to the next base.
- 14. On OVERTHROW runners may only advance 1 base, at their own risk.
- 15. When the catcher for the next inning is a baserunner, he/she must be replaced by the last batted out.
- 16. ONLY ONE UMPIRE IS REQUIRED for 7U.
 - A second umpire is optional at the discretion of the team scheduling umpires for that game.
 - During coach-pitch innings the umpire may work the bases. During player-pitch he/she will call balls/strikes.
- 17. Regular baseballs will be used in the 7U division. Safety baseball may be used only upon agreement of both coaches.
- 18. Four outfielders may be played, and roster batting applies as with other levels.
- 19. NO PROTESTS will be heard by NPGL for this division.
- 20. A pitching machine may be used for coach-pitch innings if agreed upon by both coaches.
